### MINUTES OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING JANUARY 19, 2021

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 109 (the "District") convened in regular session on Tuesday, JANUARY 19, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. via videoconference pursuant to Section 551.125, Texas Gov't Code as modified by the temporary suspension of certain provisions thereof pursuant to guidelines issued by the Texas Attorney General and approved by the Governor for use during the COVID-19 statewide disaster. A roll call was taken of the persons present:

Owen H. Parker, President Chris Green, Vice President Cheryl Moore, Secretary Robin Sulpizio, Assistant Secretary Nancy Frank, Assistant Secretary

All members of the Board were present. Also attending all or parts of the meeting were Mr. Cory Burton and Ms. Ashleigh Bass of Municipal Accounts & Consulting, LP, bookkeeper for the District; Mr. Tim Spencer of Ad Valorem Appraisals, tax assessor and collector for the District; Lieutenant Steve Romero of Harris County Precinct 4 Constable's Office; Mr. Bill Kotlan of BGE, Inc. ("BGE"), engineer for the District; Mr. Clint Gehrke of Water Waste Water Management Services, Inc. ("WWWMS"), operator for the District; and Mr. Dimitri Millas and Ms. Jane Maher of Norton Rose Fulbright US LLP ("NRF"), attorneys for the District.

Pursuant to Section 551.054, Texas Gov't Code, as modified by the temporary suspension of certain provisions thereof, notice of the meeting was posted on the District's website within the time limits prescribed by law. The agenda packet was posted on the website as items became available. Certificates of such posting are attached hereto as *Exhibit A*.

**Call to Order.** President Parker called the meeting to order. He noted that the meeting was being held by teleconference in accordance with federal, state and county directives to slow the spread of COVID-19 by avoiding meetings that bring people together. He said the notice of the meeting included a toll-free dial-in number for members of the public to call so they could hear the meeting and address the Board. He noted that the meeting was being recorded and a recording would be available upon public request. President Parker then set out guidelines for the conduct of the meeting. He asked all participants to identify themselves before speaking. He then proceeded with the meeting business:

- 1. **Public Comments**. There were no public comments.
- 2. **Minutes**. The Board considered the proposed minutes of a meeting held on December 15, 2020, previously distributed to the Board. Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Moore, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the meeting held on December 15, 2020, as presented.
- 3. **Security Report**. President Parker recognized Lt. Romero, who reviewed the Security Report for the month of December 2020, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit B*.

Upon motion by Director Moore, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Security Report.

- 4. **Interlocal Agreement for Law Enforcement Services.** The Board considered approving an Interlocal Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between Harris County and the District, a copy of which is attached as *Exhibit C*. Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Interlocal Agreement for Law Enforcement Services, as presented.
- 5. **Adopt Order Authorizing Property Tax Exemption.** The Board discussed District homestead exemptions. It was noted the District currently grants an exemption in the amount of \$25,000 of appraised value for individuals who are disabled or 65 years of age or older, which has been in place since 1982. Upon motion by Director Moore, seconded by Director Green, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to extend the current exemption for 2021 taxes in the amount of \$25,000 of appraised value for individuals who are disabled or 65 years of age or older. A copy of the Order Authorizing Exemption From Taxation is attached as *Exhibit D*.
- 6. Adopt Resolution Authorizing Additional Penalty on Delinquent Taxes. The Board considered adopting a Resolution Authorizing Additional Penalty on Delinquent Taxes pursuant to Sections 33.07, 33.11, and 33.08, Texas Tax Code, which allows an additional penalty of 20%. Mr. Millas noted that the penalty is passed through to the taxpayer to cover the fee of delinquent tax attorneys for collection.

Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Moore, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the Resolution Authorizing 20% Additional Penalty on Delinquent Taxes remaining delinquent on April 1, 2021 for personal property, and remaining delinquent on July 1, 2021 for other property, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit E*.

7. **Review Bookkeeper's Report.** President Parker recognized Ms. Bass, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Bookkeeper's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit F*. Ms. Bass reviewed disbursements from the General Operating Fund.

Upon motion by Director Sulpizio, seconded by Director Moore, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Bookkeeper's Report, to authorize payment of the checks in the amounts, to the persons, and for the purposes listed therein and to adopt the Resolution as presented.

- 8. **Engineer's Report**. President Parker recognized Mr. Kotlan, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Engineer's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit G*.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the America's Water Infrastructure Act ("AWIA") and the required Risk and Resilience Assessment and Emergency Response Plan for the District's water facilities. He requested authorization for BGE to prepare the Resilience Assessment and Emergency Response Plan for \$10,000.00.
- Mr. Kotlan stated that for the Stormwater Quality Permit renewals, Harris County is reviewing the permit submittals.
- Mr. Kotlan stated that the Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT") will be beginning construction on the road widening project, but BGE has not received the executed agreements and

have not placed any funds in escrow for the District's portion. He also stated that the District will need to provide project representation for construction of water line relocations related to the work, and that BGE plans to provide this service with BGE's construction department on an hourly basis in accordance with the master services agreement.

Mr. Kotlan stated that BGE received all approvals for the Water Plant No. 2 Expansion, and requested authorization for BGE to advertise and receive bids for the expansion.

Mr. Kotlan stated that the design is ongoing for the Barents Drive Lift Station.

Mr. Kotlan stated that BGE is working with Mr. Thomas to obtain the easements from Darrell Ashley (Dirt Cheap) for the Water Line Extension for the 11<sup>th</sup> annexation. He stated that ROW Management received a counter offer of \$12.00 per square foot. Discussion ensued. It was the consensus of the Board to provide a counter offer of \$8.50 per square foot. Mr. Kotlan requested approval of invoice no. 1 to Row Management in the amount of \$1,560.00.

Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to accept the Engineer's Report, to authorize BGE to prepare the Resilience Assessment and Emergency Response Plan for \$10,000.00, authorize BGE to advertise and receive bids for Water Plant No. 2 Expansion, and approve invoice no. 1 to Row Management in the amount of \$1,560.00.

9. **Tax Collector's Report and authorize payment of certain bills**. President Parker recognized Mr. Spencer, who reviewed the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report for the month of December 2020, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit H*.

Upon motion by Director Moore, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report and to authorize payment of check numbers 2067 through 2072, from the Tax Account to the persons, in the amounts, and for the purposes listed therein.

- 10. **Review Operations Report and authorize repairs**. President Parker recognized Mr. Gehrke, who presented the Operations Report dated January 19, 2021 and a list of delinquent accounts, copies of which are attached hereto as *Exhibit I*. Mr. Gehrke reported that 92.34% of the water pumped was billed for the period December 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.
  - Mr. Gehrke reported on various maintenance items.

The Board discussed the delinquent process. It was the consensus of the Board to have WWWMS continue to deliver delinquent notices, but to not terminate services, and to further discuss the termination process at the February board meeting.

Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Operations Report.

11. **Report on Eminent Domain Filing.** Mr. Millas reported that the District is required to file an annual report on eminent domain activities with the Texas Comptroller's office by February 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. He stated that the District has had no eminent domain activities, and that NRF has filed the report on behalf of the District. No action is requested of the Board on this item.

The Commission shall provide a form that may be used to make such a request on its internet website.

#### TRAFFIC:

Contract patrol deputies made multiple traffic stops, enforcing the traffic laws of the state of Texas, within the contract reducing the possibility of accidents and lessening the chance of repeat offenders in the patrolled areas.

Contract patrol deputies responded to 15 local alarms at various locations within the community. They were handled without incident and were all found to be false alarms.

# INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES BETWEEN HARRIS COUNTY AND HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 109

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between HARRIS COUNTY, TEXAS hereinafter referred to as the "County," acting by and through its governing body, the Harris County Commissioners Court, and the HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 109 (the "District") acting by and through its governing body.

### **RECITALS:**

This Agreement is made pursuant to chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, which authorizes contracts between counties and local governments for the performance of governmental functions and services; and

The District desires to obtain the services of the Harris County Constable Precinct 4 (the "Constable") to provide law enforcement services within District's geographical area as further defined in Exhibit "A".

**NOW THEREFORE**, the County and the District, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, do mutually agree as follows:

### **TERMS:**

### I. TERM

1.1 The services to be performed under this Agreement shall begin on March 1, 2021, and end on February 28, 2022, unless terminated sooner in accordance with the provisions of Section IV.

### II. SERVICES

- 2.1 The County agrees to authorize the Constable to provide 2 deputy(ies) to devote seventy percent (70%) of their working time to provide law enforcement services related to the District's geographical area (the "area"), as further defined in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof. "Law enforcement services" include, but are not limited to, patrolling, preparing reports, appearing in court, investigating crimes, arresting persons, and transporting suspects.
- 2.2 As used herein, the phrase "working time" is defined as follows: the usual or normal hours that the Constable's deputies are required to work in any calendar month, and does not include any extra or overtime work. The consideration for the law enforcement services provided herein includes a share of the costs to the County for such times when deputies are not available. Vacation and sick leave are earned through County

service, and funeral leave is a benefit available to County employees. Therefore, "working time" shall not include vacation, sick leave, funeral leave or other county-benefit leave, and it is not anticipated that the Constable will authorize substitute deputies to work within the area when the regularly assigned deputies are not available.

- 2.3 The Constable shall retain control and supervision of the deputies performing services under this agreement to the same extent as he does other deputies. The District understands and agrees that this Agreement is not intended, nor shall it be construed, to obligate the Constable to assign deputies to devote any portion of their working time to the area, including but not limited to circumstances like officer funerals and natural disasters.
- 2.4 As the Constable retains control and supervision of the deputies and services, the District may not, based on late payment or non-payment by one of its members to the District of funds for District operations, or the law enforcement services of the Constable, limit or deny access of such members to the services of the Constable. All members shall be provided the same telephone numbers and electronic access means to contact the Constable.

### III. CONSIDERATION FOR SERVICES

3.1 The District agrees to pay the County the sum of \$148,734.00 for 2 deputy(ies) for a total sum of ONE HUNDRED FORTY EIGHT THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY FOUR AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$148,734.00) to be used by the County for the purpose of paying seventy percent (70%) of the full-time equivalent cost to the County for supplying the law enforcement services, including salaries, benefits, vacation, sick leave, and any additional expenses the County may incur in providing the services under this Agreement. Each party paying for the performance of governmental functions or services must make those payments from current revenues available to the paying party.

The District agrees to make payments on the total sum in installments, which are due and payable, without demand, on the following dates in the amounts set forth next to the dates:

The monthly installments are due and payable before 10:00 a.m. at the office of the County Treasurer, Dept. 101, P.O. Box 4354, Houston, TX 77210-4354. If the County provides the option, payment may be made by same time and date by electronic means to an account designated by the County.

Regarding the first payment due on February 20, 2021, the first payment is due on the latter of February 20, 2021, or five (5) days after the District receives a fully executed copy of this Agreement from the County.

# IV. DEFAULT AND TERMINATION

- 4.1 The District understands and agrees that if the County does not receive the monthly payments within thirty (30) days of the date due, the County is authorized to terminate this Agreement without further notice. The County's failure to make demand for payments due is not a waiver of the District's obligation to make timely payment.
- 4.2 If the District defaults in the payment of any obligation hereunder, the District is liable to the County for an interest assessment of one percent (1%) on the unpaid amount. Interest shall thereafter compound monthly at one percent (1%) on unpaid amounts and interest assessments from the date of default until paid. This interest is in addition to any monies due for law enforcement services rendered hereunder. Interest on all past due amounts shall not exceed the maximum amount of nonusurious interest that may be contracted for, taken, charged, or received under law. Any interest in excess of that maximum amount shall be refunded. The District is also liable for attorney's fees and costs should the matter have to go to litigation for collection.
- 4.3 If the District is dissatisfied in any way with the performance of the County, the Constable or the deputies under this Agreement, the District's sole remedy is termination under Section 4.4.
- 4.4 Either party may terminate this Agreement prior to the expiration of the term set forth in this Agreement, with or without cause, upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other party. The County will submit an invoice to the District showing the amounts due for the month in which termination occurs. The District agrees to pay the final invoice within ten (10) days of receipt.
- 4.5 If this Agreement is terminated at any time other than at the end of a contract month, the monthly installment or payment for such contract month will be prorated, less any unpaid amounts and interest under Paragraph 4.2.
- 4.6 In the event the Constable informs Commissioners Court and the District in writing that due to position vacancy or elimination occurring on or after March 1, 2021, the Constable cannot or will not provide 2 deputy(ies) to devote seventy percent (70%) of

their working time to provide law enforcement services related to the District's geographical area, and provided that the District has prepaid its sum and further provided that such notice from the Constable identifies that such vacancy or elimination was of a position that served or facilitated service to the District, the District shall receive a refund equal to the number of days between the date of the Constable's notice and a subsequent meeting of Commissioners Court at which Commissioners Court amends or terminates the Agreement.

### V. NOTICE

5.1 Any notice required to be given under the provisions of this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be duly served when it shall have been deposited, enclosed in a wrapper with the proper postage prepaid thereon, and duly registered or certified, return receipt requested, in a United States Post Office, addressed to the parties at the following addresses:

5.2 Either party may designate a different address by giving the other party ten days' written notice.

### VI. MERGER

6.1 The parties agree that this Agreement contains all of the terms and conditions of the understanding of the parties relating to the subject matter hereof. All prior negotiations, discussions, correspondence and preliminary understandings between the parties and others relating hereto are superseded by this Agreement.

### VII. MISCELLANEOUS

- 7.1 This instrument contains the entire Agreement between the parties relating to the rights granted and the obligations assumed. Any oral or written representations or modifications concerning this instrument shall be of no force and effect excepting a subsequent modification in writing signed by both parties.
- 7.2 Unless otherwise consented to and approved by Commissioners Court, agreement modifications that increase funding, personnel positions or geographical area can only be approved on a quarterly basis, and the effective date must coincide with the beginning of a pay period. Agreement modifications that decrease funding, personnel positions or geographical area may be approved at a regularly scheduled meeting of Commissioners Court, and the effective date must coincide with the end of a pay period, unless otherwise agreed to by the parties.
- 7.3 This Agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts, each having equal force and effect of an original.
- 7.4 This Agreement is not in effect until it has been signed by the District and it has received the approval by the Harris County Commissioners Court and the Constable.

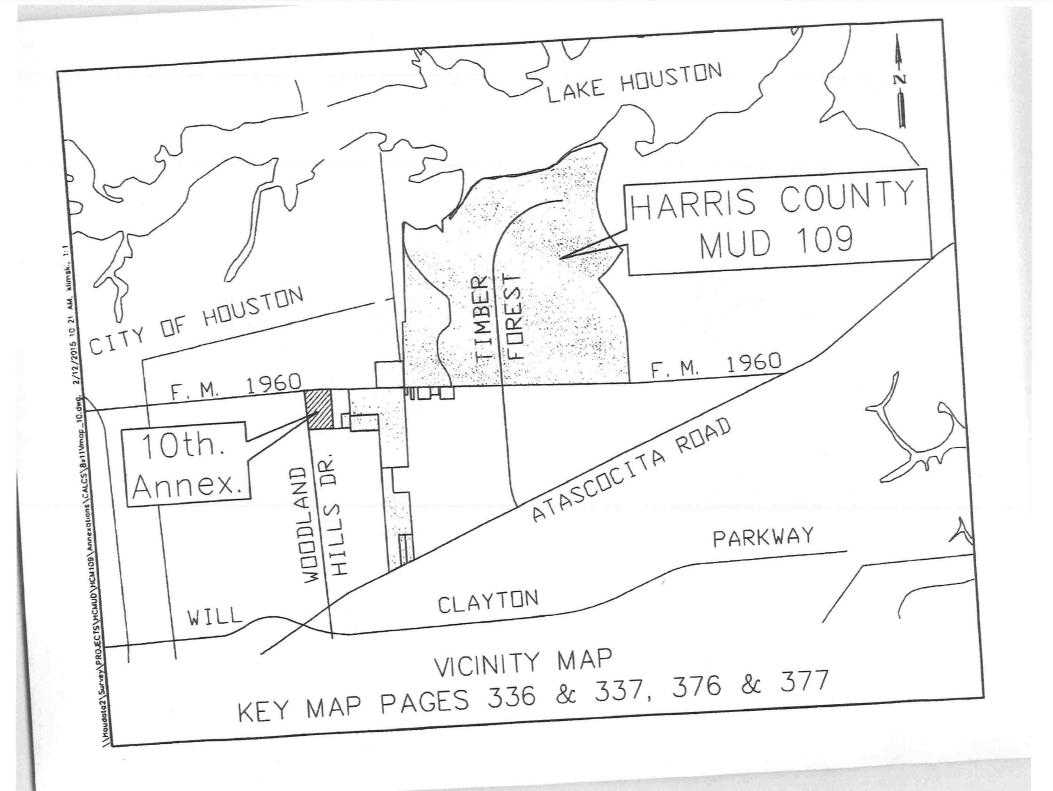

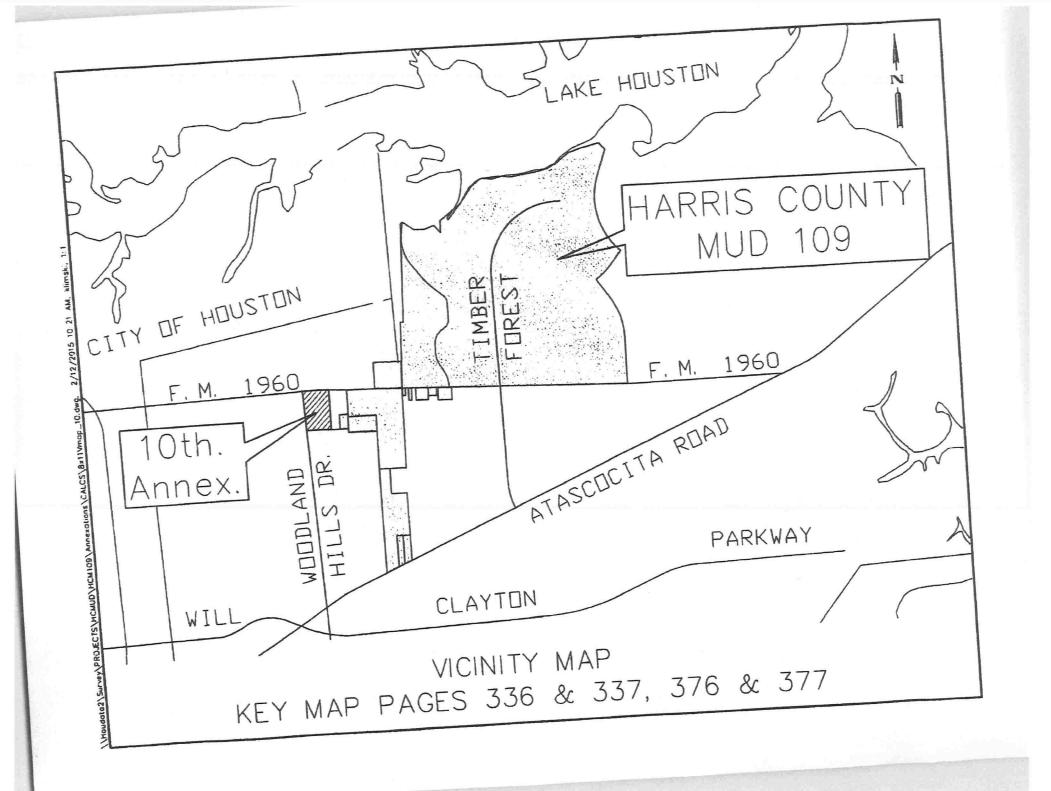

# ORDER ADOPTING EXEMPTION FROM TAXATION FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE DISABLED OR ARE 65 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 8, Section 1-b of the Constitution of the State of Texas and pursuant to V.T.C.A., Tax Code §11.13(d), the Board of Directors (the "Board") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 109 (the "District") is authorized to adopt exemptions from taxation of not less than \$3,000 of the appraised value of the residence homesteads of individuals who are disabled or are 65 years of age or older;

WHEREAS, the Board has been advised that granting such an exemption will not impair the District's obligation to levy taxes for payment of its debts or cause a substantial negative impact on the tax rolls of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it appropriate to adopt such exemption;

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 109 THAT:

I.

Effective January 1, 2021 and thereafter until modified by order of the Board, an exemption of \$25,000 of the appraised value of residence homesteads within the District is available for individuals who are disabled or are 65 years of age or older.

II.

Such individuals may be granted such exemption upon direct application to the chief appraiser for the Harris County Appraisal District.

III.

The President or Vice President is authorized to execute and the Secretary or Assistant Secretary is authorized to attest this Order on behalf of the Board and to do all things necessary and proper to carry out the purposes and intent hereof.

# RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL PENALTY ON DELINQUENT TAXES UNDER SECTIONS 33.07, 33.11 AND 33.08, TAX CODE

WHEREAS, Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 109 (the "District") has contracted with private legal counsel to enforce collection of delinquent property taxes pursuant to Section 6.30, Texas Tax Code or, alternatively, another taxing unit that collects taxes for the District has contracted with private legal counsel under Section 6.30;

WHEREAS, such private legal counsel is entitled to compensation as set forth in the contract equal to 20% of the amount of delinquent tax, penalty, and interest collected and subject to the contract;

WHEREAS, Section 33.07 of the Texas Tax Code authorizes the District to provide that taxes that become delinquent on or after February 1 of a year but not later than May 1 of that year and remain delinquent on July 1 of the year in which they become delinquent incur an additional penalty which may not exceed the amount of compensation specified in the contract with an attorney under Section 6.30 of the Tax Code, in order to defray costs of collection;

WHEREAS, Section 33.11 of the Texas Tax Code authorizes the District to provide that taxes on tangible personal property that become delinquent on or after February 1 of a year may incur an additional penalty on a date that occurs before July 1 of the year in which the taxes become delinquent if the District has contracted with an attorney under Section 6.30 and the taxes on the personal property become subject to the attorney's contract before July 1 of the year in which the taxes become delinquent; and

WHEREAS, Section 33.08 of the Texas Tax Code authorizes the District to provide that taxes that become delinquent on or after June 1 under Sections 26.07(f), 26.15(e), 31.03, 31.031, 31.032, or 31.04 incur an additional penalty which may not exceed the amount of compensation specified in the contract with an attorney under Section 6.30 of the Tax Code, in order to defray costs of collection;

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the District that:

- (1) all 2020 taxes on tangible personal property which become delinquent on or after February 1, 2021 and remain delinquent on April 1, 2021 incur an additional penalty equal to the compensation specified in the contract with the attorney to be paid in connection with the collection of the delinquent taxes.
- (2) all 2020 taxes on property other than tangible personal property which become delinquent on or after February 1, 2021 but not later than May 1, 2021 and remain delinquent on July 1, 2021 incur an additional penalty of 20% of the delinquent tax, penalty and interest, in order to defray costs of collection.
- (3) all taxes which become delinquent on or after June 1 of the year in which they become delinquent under Sections 26.07(f), 26.15(e), 31.03, 31.031, 31.032, or 31.04 incur an additional penalty of 20% of the delinquent tax, penalty and interest, in order to defray costs of collection.

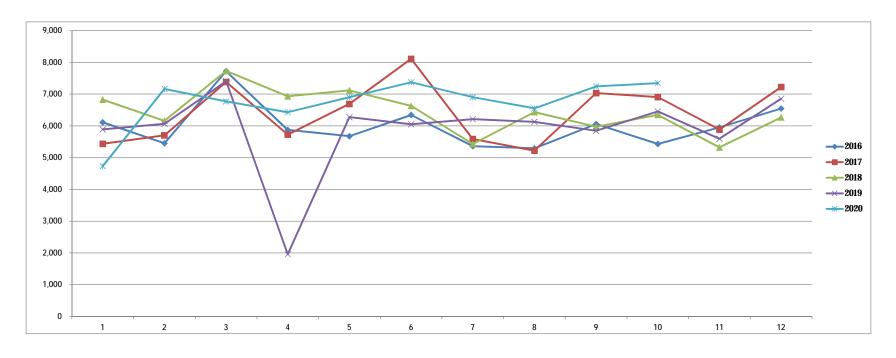

**9. Review Engineer's Report**, including approval of pay estimates, authorization of change orders to pending construction contracts, and authorization of capacity commitments:

### a. American Water Infrastructure Act (2018)

On October 23, 2018, America's Water Infrastructure Act (AWIA) was signed into law. AWIA Section 2013 requires community (drinking) water systems serving more than 3,300 people to develop (then update every 5 year) a Risk and Resilience Assessments (RRA) and Emergency Response Plan (ERP).

### RRA (required by June, 2021) is intended to assess the following:

- Risk to the system from malevolent acts and natural hazard,
- Resilience of the pipes and constructed conveyances, physical barriers, source water, and water collection,
- Monitoring practices of the system,
- Financial infrastructure of the system,
- Use, storage, or handling of various chemicals by the system,
- Operation and maintenance of the system.

### ERP (Required by December 2021) is intended to provide the following:

- Develop strategies and resources to improve the resilience of the system, including the physical security and cybersecurity of the system;
- Prepare plans and procedures that can be implemented, and identification of equipment that can be utilized, in the event of a malevolent act or natural hazard that threatens the ability of the community water system to deliver safe drinking water;

• Determine actions, procedures and equipment which can mitigate or eliminate the impact of a malevolent act or natural hazard on the public health and the safety and supply of drinking water provided to communities and individuals.

BGE proposes to complete both the Risk & Resilience Assessment (RRA) and the Emergency Response Plan (ERP) for the District simultaneously and certify completion as required by the Act for a lump sum fee of \$10,000.

Action Item: Authorize BGE to complete the RRA and ERP required by the Americal Water Infrastructure Act for a fee of \$10,000.

- b. Stormwater Quality Permit Renewals: Harris County is reviewing permit submittals.
- c. Water Plant No. 1 EST Rehabilitation: Warranty review date 10/14/2021.
- d. Utility Relocations related to FM 1960 Widening: Update

TxDOT will be beginning construction this week on the road widening project, but we have not received our executed agreements yet and have not placed funds in escrow for the Districts portion. The District will need to provide project representation for construction of water line relocations related to the work. BGE plans to provide this service with our construction department on an hourly basis in accordance with our master services agreement.

### e. Water Plant No. 2 Expansion

We have received all approvals and request authorization to bid the project.

Action Item: Authorize Engineer to advertise and receive bids for Water Plant No. 2 Expansion.

### f. Barents Drive Lift Station

Design is ongoing, expect submittal to agencies in February.

### g. Water Line Extension (Annexation 11)

Working on easements for obtaining an easement from Darrell Ashley (Dirt Cheap). Copies of proposed easements along with topography are included. We recommend approval of ROW Management invoice for 30% completion (attached).

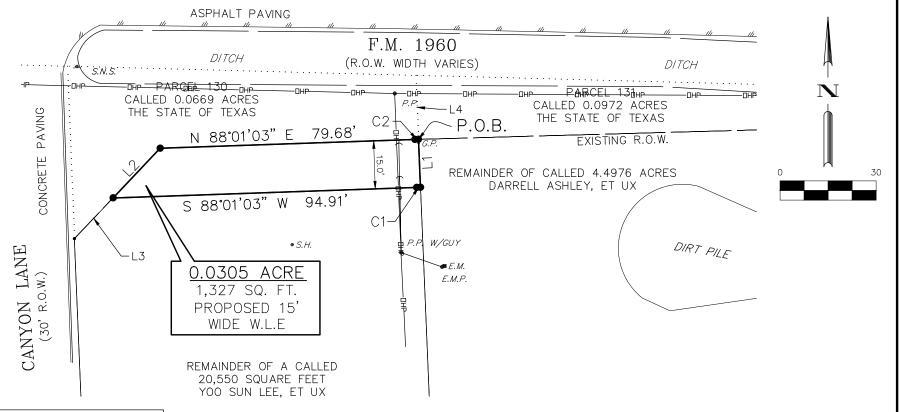
