Summary of Events

Alarms:

Deputies responded to 18 alarm calls.

Checks:

Deputies conducted 337 combined MUD, park, neighborhood, and other miscellaneous checks.

Traffic Enforcement:

Deputies conducted numerous traffic stops and traffic initiatives throughout the contract during the month in the interest of public safety, and in an attempt to reduce the risk of motor vehicle accidents.

5800 FM 1960 Rd. E. – Deputy initiated a traffic stop. Investigation revealed the driver to be intoxicated. Driver was taken in to custody.

4600 FM 1960 Rd. E – Deputy initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle for a traffic infraction. Investigation revealed the driver did not have a license or insurance, driver was cited and vehicle

towed.

5400 FM 1960 Rd. E. – Deputy initiated a traffic stop. Investigation revealed the driver was in possession of illegal narcotics. Driver was taken in to custody.

4500 FM 1960 Rd. E – Deputy responded to a DWI type call. Investigation revealed driver to be intoxicated. Driver was arrested.

Burglary Habitation:
