MINUTES OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING NOVEMBER 17, 2020

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 109 (the "District") convened in regular session on Tuesday, NOVEMBER 17, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. via videoconference pursuant to Section 551.125, Texas Gov't Code as modified by the temporary suspension of certain provisions thereof pursuant to guidelines issued by the Texas Attorney General and approved by the Governor for use during the COVID-19 statewide disaster. A roll call was taken of the persons present:

Owen H. Parker, President Chris Green, Vice President Cheryl Moore, Secretary Robin Sulpizio, Assistant Secretary Nancy Frank, Assistant Secretary

All members of the Board were present. Also attending all or parts of the meeting were Mr. Cory Burton and Ms. Ashleigh Bass of Municipal Accounts & Consulting, LP, bookkeeper for the District; Mr. Tim Spencer of Ad Valorem Appraisals, tax assessor and collector for the District; Lieutenant Steve Romero of Harris County Precinct 4 Constable's Office; Mr. Bill Kotlan of BGE, Inc. ("BGE"), engineer for the District; Mr. Clint Gehrke of Water Waste Water Management Services, Inc. ("WWWMS"), operator for the District; and Mr. Dimitri Millas and Ms. Jane Maher of Norton Rose Fulbright US LLP ("NRF"), attorneys for the District.

Pursuant to Section 551.054, Texas Gov't Code, as modified by the temporary suspension of certain provisions thereof, notice of the meeting was posted on the District's website within the time limits prescribed by law. The agenda packet was posted on the website as items became available. Certificates of such posting are attached hereto as *Exhibit A*.

Call to Order. President Parker called the meeting to order. He noted that the meeting was being held by teleconference in accordance with federal, state and county directives to slow the spread of COVID-19 by avoiding meetings that bring people together. He said the notice of the meeting included a toll-free dial-in number for members of the public to call so they could hear the meeting and address the Board. He noted that the meeting was being recorded and a recording would be available upon public request. President Parker then set out guidelines for the conduct of the meeting. He asked all participants to identify themselves before speaking. He then proceeded with the meeting business:

- 1. **Public Comments**. There were no public comments.
- 2. **Minutes**. The Board considered the proposed minutes of a meeting held on October 20, 2020, previously distributed to the Board. Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the meeting held on October 20, 2020, as presented.
- 3. **Security Report**. President Parker recognized Lieutenant Romero, who reviewed the Security Report for the month of October 2020, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit B*. Upon

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motion by Director Moore, seconded by Director Green, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Security Report.

4. **Tax Collector's Report and authorize payment of certain bills**. President Parker recognized Mr. Spencer, who reviewed the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report for the month of October 2020, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit C*.

Upon motion by Director Frank, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report and to authorize payment of check numbers 2067 through 2072, from the Tax Account to the persons, in the amounts, and for the purposes listed therein.

5. **Review Bookkeeper's Report.** President Parker recognized Ms. Bass, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Bookkeeper's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit D*. Ms. Bass reviewed disbursements from the General Operating Fund.

Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Moore, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Bookkeeper's Report, to authorize payment of the checks in the amounts, to the persons, and for the purposes listed therein and to adopt the Resolution as presented.

- 6. **Engineer's Report**. President Parker recognized Mr. Kotlan, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Engineer's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit E*.
- Mr. Kotlan stated that for the Stormwater Quality Permit renewals, Harris County required that BGE renew the individual permits that are expired separately and then Harris County can combine them. He stated that BGE has prepared the permit renewals for two permits that lapsed earlier in the year.
- Mr. Kotlan stated that the warranty work is complete for the Water Plant No. 2 EST Rehabilitation, and that the tank is back in service.
- Mr. Kotlan stated that the warranty review date for the Water Plant No. 1 EST Rehabilitation is October 14, 2021.
- Mr. Kotlan provided an update on the utility relocations related to the FM 1960 widening. He stated that BGE had updated the estimates for the agreements with the Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT"). He stated that BGE is waiting on TxDOT for the approved and executed agreements prior to transferring the escrow funds.
- Mr. Kotlan stated that BGE has received approval from Harris County for the Water Plant No. 2 Expansion, and that BGE is still waiting on the approval from the City of Houston.
- Mr. Kotlan stated that the Barents Drive Lift Station is in design. He also stated that the District will need an easement to get the pipe from the lift station back to FM 1960. He noted that BGE is surveying the area to prepare an exhibit.
- Mr. Kotlan reported that the design for the rehabilitation of the Wastewater Treatment Plant is underway. He stated that BGE is working with the plant operator on the replacement of the gear drives and hand wheels on sluice gates and relocation of a modular building for operations and District use.

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Mr. Kotlan reported that the District has offered a water service agreement to the Lee family for the extension of water service to 4410 FM 1960 E. He stated that the Lee family is currently reviewing the agreement.

Upon motion by Director Sulpizio, seconded by Director Moore, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to accept the Engineer's Report.

- 7. **Review Operations Report and authorize repairs**. President Parker recognized Mr. Gehrke, who presented the Operations Report dated November 17, 2020 and a list of delinquent accounts, copies of which are attached hereto as *Exhibit F*. Mr. Gehrke reported that 93.69% of the water pumped was billed for the period October 1, 2020 through October 31, 2020.
 - Mr. Gehrke reported on various maintenance items.

The Board discussed the delinquent process. It was the consensus of the Board to have WWWMS continue to deliver delinquent notices, but to not terminate services, and to further discuss the termination process at the December board meeting.

Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Operations Report.

8. **Review Arbitrage Engagement**. President Parker recognized Mr. Millas, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Engagement Letter for Arbitrage Compliance Services for the Unlimited Tax Refunding Bonds, Series 2008, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit G*. Upon motion by Director Moore, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Engagement Letter for Arbitrage Compliance Services for the Unlimited Tax Refunding Bonds, Series 2008.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE BOARD, the meeting was adjourned.

Summary of Events

Alarms:
