MINUTES OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MARCH 15, 2022

THE STATE OF TEXAS COUNTY OF HARRIS HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 109

The Board of Directors (the "*Board*") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 109 (the "*District*") met in regular session, open to the public, at the Atascocita Waste Water Treatment Plant, 5003 Atascocita Road, Humble, Texas 77346, and via teleconference, on March 15, 2022 at 5:30 p.m.; whereupon the roll was called of the Board, to-wit:

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Owen H. Parker, President Chris Green, Vice President Cheryl Moore, Secretary Robin Sulpizio, Assistant Secretary Nancy A. Frank, Assistant Secretary

All members of the Board were present. Also attending all or parts of the meeting were Ms. Cindy Grimes of Municipal Accounts & Consulting, LP ("MAC"), bookkeeper for the District; Lieutenant Steve Romero of Harris County Precinct 4 Constable's Office; Mr. Tim Spencer of Ad Valorem Appraisals, tax assessor and collector for the District; Mr. Bill Kotlan of BGE, Inc. ("BGE"), engineer for the District; Mr. Clint Gehrke of Water Waste Water Management Services, Inc. ("WWWMS"), operator for the District; and Mr. Dimitri Millas and Ms. Jane Maher of Norton Rose Fulbright US LLP ("NRF"), attorneys for the District.

Call to Order. President Parker called the meeting to order in accordance with notice posted pursuant to law, copies of certificates of posting of which are attached hereto as *Exhibit A*, and the following business was transacted:

1. Board finding of existence of emergency or public necessity making the convening at one location of a quorum of the governmental body difficult or impossible and permitting a meeting by telephone pursuant to Section 551.125 of the Texas Open Meetings Act. Upon motion by Director Sulpizio, seconded by Director Green, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to find the existence of an emergency or public necessity making the convening at one location of a quorum of the governmental body difficult or impossible and permitting a meeting by telephone pursuant to Section 551.125 of the Texas Open Meetings Act. Upon motion being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to find the existence of an emergency or public necessity making the convening at one location of a quorum of the governmental body difficult or impossible and permitting a meeting by telephone pursuant to Section 551.125 of the Texas Open Meetings Act due to COVID-19.

2. **Public Comments**. There were no public comments.

3. **Minutes**. The Board considered the proposed minutes of meeting held on February 15, 2022, previously distributed to the Board. Upon motion by Director Moore, seconded by Director Frank, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the meeting held on February 15, 2022, as presented.

4. **Security Report**. Lieutenant Romero reviewed the Security Report for the month of February 2022, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit B*. Upon motion by Director Sulpizio, seconded by Director Moore, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Security Report.

5. **Cancel the election and Adopt Order Declaring Unopposed Candidates Elected to Office.** Mr. Millas reviewed an Order Declaring Unopposed Candidates Elected to Office (the "Order") and the Certification of Unopposed Status (the "Certification"), copies of which are attached hereto as *Exhibit C*. Mr. Millas noted that Director Moore, Sulpizio and Frank are unopposed and therefore the Board can cancel the directors election scheduled for May 7, 2022.

Upon motion by Director Sulpizio, seconded by Director Frank, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the Order, as presented, thereby canceling the directors election scheduled for May 7, 2022.

6. **Review Bookkeeper's Report.** President Parker recognized Ms. Grimes, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Bookkeeper's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit D.*

Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Bookkeeper's Report and to authorize payment of the checks in the amounts, to the persons, and for the purposes listed therein, to adopt the Bookkeeper's Report as presented.

7. **Engineer's Report**. President Parker recognized Mr. Kotlan, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Engineer's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit E*.

Mr. Kotlan reported on the utility relocations related to the FM 1960 widening and stated that the contractor, Angel Brothers is currently relocating the District's water line and that no action is required.

Mr. Kotlan reported that for the Water Plant No. 2 Expansion, and presented Pay Estimate No. 9 in the amount of \$153,437.57 for approval. He stated that the work includes work on the booster pump station and operations building.

Mr. Kotlan reported on the Water Line extension and stated that BGE is preparing the contract documents and expects to begin construction to begin next week.

Mr. Kotlan reported on the Wastewater Treatment Plant permit renewal and stated that the permit renewal is in process and is expected to be submitted in June of 2022.

Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to accept the Engineer's Report and approve Pay Estimate No. 9 to Schier Construction Company, Inc. in the amount of \$153,437.57.

8. **Review Operations Report and authorize repairs**. President Parker recognized Mr. Gehrke, who presented the Operations Report dated March 15, 2022 and a list of delinquent accounts, copies of which are attached hereto as *Exhibit F*. Mr. Gehrke reported that 91.35% of the water pumped was billed for the period February 1, 2021 through February 28, 2022.

Mr. Gehrke reported on various maintenance items. He provided the estimates of pricing to clean Lift Stations Nos. 1, 2, 3, 5 and 6. He stated that the estimate for Lift Station No. 1 is \$8,000.00, the estimate for Lift Station No. 2 is \$2,500.00, the estimate for Lift Station No. 3 is \$3,000.00, and the estimates for Lift Station No. 5 and 6 is \$2,000.00 each.

Upon motion by Director Frank, seconded by Director Moore, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Operations Report and to approve termination of the delinquent accounts in accordance with the terms of the District's Rate Order.

9. **Discuss renewal of District Insurance (expires May 22, 2022).** This item was deferred until the next meeting.

10. **Tax Collector's Report and authorize payment of certain bills**. President Parker recognized Mr. Spencer, who reviewed the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report for the month of February 2022, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit G*.

Upon motion by Director Frank, seconded by Director Moore, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report and to authorize payment of check numbers 2193 through 2205, from the Tax Account to the persons, in the amounts, and for the purposes listed therein.

11. **Engage delinquent tax attorney to enforce the collection of delinquent taxes.** Mr. Millas stated that the District has an evergreen contract with Perdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins & Mott, LLP ("Perdue") for delinquent collections. Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to engage Perdue to enforce the collection of delinquent taxes.

12. Discuss meeting format and meeting locations, and such other matters as may properly come before it. It was the consensus of the Board to hold the next meeting in person at the Atascocita Waste Water Treatment Plant.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE BOARD, the meeting was adjourned.






