MINUTES OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING NOVEMBER 15, 2022

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 109 (the "District") met in regular session, open to the public, at the Atascocita Waste Water Treatment Plant, 5003 Atascocita Road, Humble, Texas 77346, on November 15, 2022 at 5:30 p.m.; whereupon the roll was called of the Board, to-wit:

Owen H. Parker, President Chris Green, Vice President Cheryl Moore, Secretary Robin Sulpizio, Assistant Secretary Nancy A. Frank, Assistant Secretary

All members of the Board were present. Also attending all or parts of the meeting were Lieutenant Steve Romero and Corporal Jeff Shipley of Harris County Precinct 4 Constable's Office; Mr. Tim Spencer and Mr. Chris Davy of Ad Valorem Appraisals, tax assessor and collector for the District; Mr. Cory Burton of Municipal Accounts & Consulting, LP ("MAC"), bookkeeper for the District; Mr. Bill Kotlan of BGE, Inc. ("BGE"), engineer for the District; Mr. Clint Gehrke and Mr. Evan Gehrke of Water Waste Water Management Services, Inc. ("WWWMS"), operator for the District; and Mr. Dimitri Millas, Ms. Leslie Bacon and Ms. Jane Maher of Norton Rose Fulbright US LLP ("NRF"), attorneys for the District.

Call to Order. President Parker called the meeting to order in accordance with notice posted pursuant to law, copies of certificates of posting of which are attached hereto as *Exhibit A*, and the following business was transacted:

- 1. **Public Comments**. There were no public comments.
- 2. **Minutes**. The Board considered the proposed minutes of meeting held on October 18, 2022, previously distributed to the Board. Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Frank, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the meeting held on October 18, 2022, as presented.
- 3. **Security Report**. President Parker recognized Lieutenant Romero, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Security Report for the month of October 2022, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit B*.
- 4. **Tax Collector's Report and authorize payment of certain bills**. President Parker recognized Mr. Spencer, who reviewed the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report for the month of October 2022, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit C*.

Upon motion by Director Sulpizio, seconded by Director Frank, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report and to authorize payment of check numbers 2247 through 2249, from the Tax Account to the persons, in the amounts, and for the purposes listed therein.

5. Review Bookkeeper's Report, and authorize payment of certain bills, and approve quarterly investment report. President Parker recognized Mr. Burton, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Bookkeeper's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit D*.

Upon motion by Director Frank, seconded by Director Moore, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Bookkeeper's Report and to authorize payment of the checks in the amounts, to the persons, and for the purposes listed therein, to adopt the Bookkeeper's Report as presented.

- 6. **Engineer's Report**. President Parker recognized Mr. Kotlan, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Engineer's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit F*
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the utility relocations related to the FM 1960 widening and stated that the contractor is preparing a change order for the water line on project.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the Water Plant No. 2 Expansion, and presented Pay Estimate No. 17 in the amount of \$51,202.72 for approval. He stated that the work includes final punch list work. He noted that what is remaining is the record drawings and operating manuals, which have been submitted. He stated that there is still a \$97,000 retainage.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the Barents Drive Lift Station. He stated that BGE is working on resolving comments from the City of Houston.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the Wastewater Treatment Plant and stated that the project is in construction.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the Wastewater Treatment Plant Permit Renewal. He stated that the draft permit has been advertised and BGE is in the final public review period.
- Mr. Kotlan discussed the service requests. He stated that BGE is working with the developer and engineer of the Madden tract to determine utility extension costs. He reported on Zimmerman Properties and stated that the developer's engineer is reviewing the feasibility.

Upon motion by Director Frank, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to accept the Engineer's Report and to approve Pay Estimate No. 17 to Schier Construction Company, Inc. in the amount of \$51,202.72.

- 7. Review Operations Report, authorize repairs, approve termination of delinquent accounts in accordance with the District's Rate Order. President Parker recognized Mr. Gehrke, who presented the Operations Report dated November 15, 2022 and a list of delinquent accounts, copies of which are attached hereto as *Exhibit F*. Mr. Gehrke reported that 100% of the water pumped was billed for the period October 1, 2022 through October 31, 2022.
 - Mr. Gehrke reported on various maintenance items.
- Mr. Gehrke reported that the interconnect with Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 46 ("No. 46") was opened on August 4, 2022 and closed on October 25, 2022. Discussion ensued.

It was the consensus of the Board to include the discussion of the District's rate order on the December agenda.

Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Frank, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Operations Report and to approve termination of the delinquent accounts in accordance with the terms of the District's Rate Order.

8. **Such other matters that may come before the Board.** There were no further reports.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE BOARD, the meeting was adjourned.

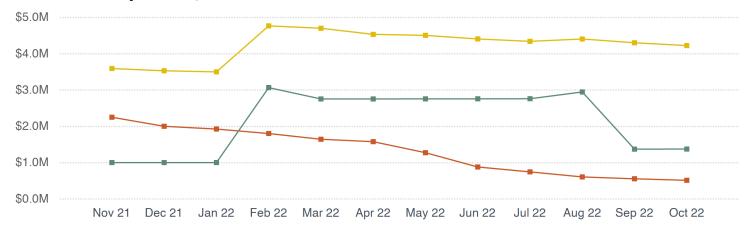

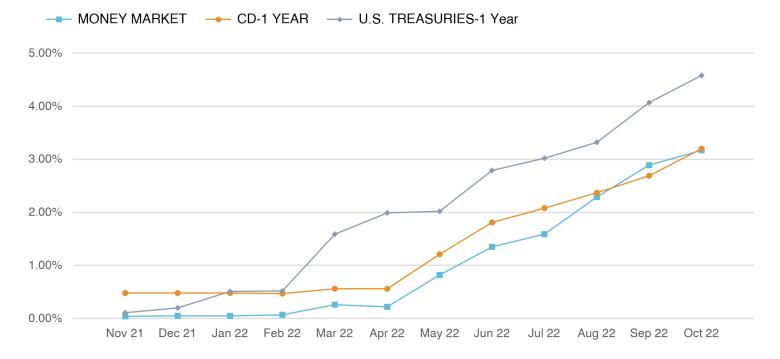

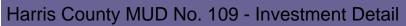
