MINUTES OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING APRIL 18, 2023

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 109 (the "District") met in regular session, open to the public, at the Atascocita Waste Water Treatment Plant, 5003 Atascocita Road, Humble, Texas 77346, on April 18, 2023, at 5:30 p.m.; whereupon the roll was called of the Board, to-wit:

Owen H. Parker, President Chris Green, Vice President Cheryl Moore, Secretary Robin Sulpizio, Assistant Secretary Nancy A. Frank, Assistant Secretary

All members of the Board were present. Also attending all or parts of the meeting were Sargent J. Morales of Harris County Precinct 4 Constable's Office; Mr. Cory Burton of Municipal Accounts & Consulting, LP ("MAC"), bookkeeper for the District; Mr. Bill Kotlan of BGE, Inc. ("BGE"), engineer for the District; Mr. Clint Gehrke and Mr. Evan Gehrke of Water Waste Water Management Services, Inc. ("WWWMS"), operator for the District; and Mr. Dimitri Millas, Ms. Leslie Bacon and Ms. Jane Maher of Norton Rose Fulbright US LLP ("NRF"), attorneys for the District.

Call to Order. President Parker called the meeting to order in accordance with notice posted pursuant to law, copies of certificates of posting of which are attached hereto as *Exhibit A*, and the following business was transacted:

- 1. **Public Comments**. There were no public comments.
- 2. **Minutes**. The Board considered the proposed minutes of meeting held on March 21, 2023, previously distributed to the Board. Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Sulpizio, full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the meeting held on March 21, 2023, as presented.
- 3. **Security Report**. President Parker recognized Sergeant Morales, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Security Report for the month of March 2023, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit B*.
- 4. Review Operations Report, authorize repairs, approve termination of delinquent accounts in accordance with the District's Rate Order. President Parker recognized Mr. Gehrke, who presented the Operations Report dated April 18, 2023 and a list of delinquent accounts, copies of which are attached hereto as *Exhibit C.* Mr. Gehrke reported that 92.40% of the water pumped was billed for the period March 1, 2023 through March 31, 2023.
 - Mr. Gehrke reported on various maintenance items.
- Mr. Gehrke reviewed the Annual Identity Theft Prevention Theft Prevention Program Report, a copy of which is attached to the Operations Report. He reported that there were no

incidences to report and that WWWMS doesn't recommend any changes at this time.

Mr. Gehrke reviewed a customer letter requesting an adjustment due to a previous high bill. Discussion ensued. It was the consensus of the Board to authorize a payment plan, with half the amount due up front.

Upon motion by Director Moore, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Operations Report and to approve termination of the delinquent accounts in accordance with the terms of the District's Rate Order.

5. **Tax Collector's Report and authorize payment of certain bills**. President Parker reviewed the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report for the month of March 2023, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit D*.

Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Frank, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report and to authorize payment of checks therein, from the Tax Account to the persons, in the amounts, and for the purposes listed therein.

6. Review Bookkeeper's Report, and authorize payment of certain bills, and approve quarterly investment report. President Parker recognized Mr. Burton, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Bookkeeper's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit E*.

Upon motion by Director Frank, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Bookkeeper's Report and to authorize payment of the checks in the amounts, to the persons, and for the purposes listed therein, to adopt the Bookkeeper's Report as presented.

- 7. **Engineer's Report**. President Parker recognized Mr. Kotlan, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Engineer's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit F*.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the utility relocations related to the FM 1960 widening and stated that the contractor if installing the water line.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the Water Plant No. 2 Expansion, and stated that BGE is working with the contractor and WWWMS to resolve warranty issues.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the Barents Drive Lift Station. He stated that the City of Houston is requiring a 20-foot easement for the forcemain. He reviewed the Correction Sanitary Sewer Line Easement, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit G*. He noted that Champions Volleyball has approved the easement.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the Wastewater Treatment Plant and stated that the project is in construction. He stated that the proposed gates are being manufactured and should be available in June.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the Wastewater Treatment Plant Permit Renewal. He stated that the final permit was received this month.

Mr. Kotlan reported on the Lead and Copper Rule Revision Update. He reviewed a summary factsheet, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit H*. He noted that the deadline for compliance with the lead service line inventory is October 16, 2024.

Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Frank, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to accept the Engineer's Report and to approve the Correction Sanitary Sewer Line Easement.

- 8. Approve corrected Sanitary Sewer Line Easement and take appropriate action. This item was addressed under the previous item.
- 9. **Renew District Insurance Policy and authorize Indemnification of Directors.** The Board reviewed the insurance proposal from Arthur J. Gallagher Waterworks Insurance Network ("WIN"), a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit I*. Mr. Millas reviewed the premium and insurance summary. Discussion ensued.
- Mr. Millas presented the Resolution Authorizing Indemnification of Directors (the "Resolution"), a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit J*. He stated that to the extent that Directors are acting in good faith in carrying out their duties, the District may indemnify Directors from losses or costs in connection with lawsuits that are not otherwise covered by the Directors and Officers liability insurance.

Upon motion by Director Frank, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the insurance Proposal from WIN and the Resolution.

10. Discuss and consider the District's affiliation with the North Harris County Regional Water Authority, and take any necessary action, and such other matters that may come before the Board. It was the consensus of the Board to not take any action.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE BOARD, the meeting was adjourned.

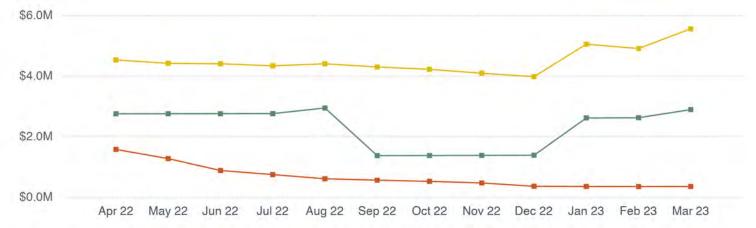

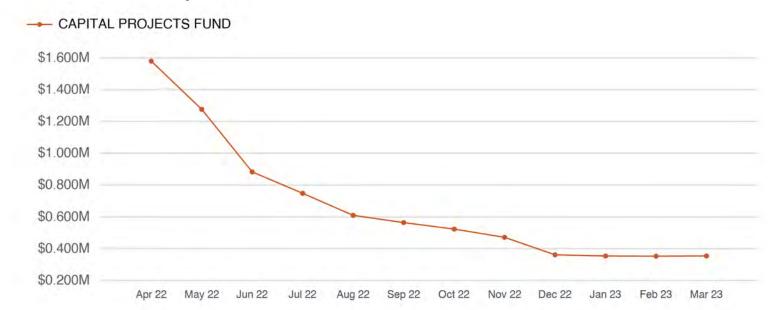

Investment Profile as of 04/18/2023



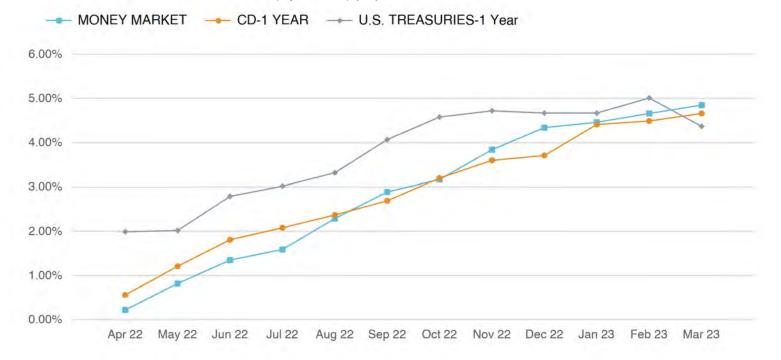

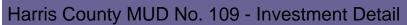

EASEMENT AREA:

GRANT OF EASEMENT:

Grantor grants to Grantee a non-exclusive perpetual right-of-way and easement for the construction, installation, repair, replacement, removal, maintenance and operation of a sanitary sewer line and all related appurtenances thereto (the "Facilities") on, over, under, across, along and through the Easement Area.

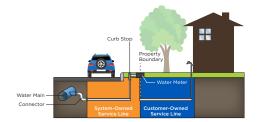

Terms and Conditions

The following terms and conditions (these "Terms") govern your relationship with Gallagher unless you have separately entered into a written services agreement with Gallagher relative to the policies and services outlined in this Proposal, in which case that services agreement will govern and control with respect to any conflicts with these Terms. These Terms will become effective upon your execution of the Client Authorization to Bind Coverage (the "CAB") included in this Proposal and shall survive for the duration of your relationship with Gallagher relative to the policies placed pursuant to the CAB or otherwise at your request.

Services

Gallagher will represent and assist you in all discussions and transactions with insurance companies relating to the lines of insurance coverage set forth in the CAB and any other lines of insurance coverage with which you request Gallagher's assistance. Gallagher will consult with you regarding any matters involving these or other coverages for which you have engaged Gallagher. You have the sole discretion for approving any insurance policies placed, as well as all other material decisions involving your risk management, risk transfer and/or loss prevention needs.

Although you are responsible for notifying applicable insurance companies directly in connection with any claims, demands, suits, notices of potential claims or any other matters as required by the terms and conditions of your policies, Gallagher will assist you in determining applicable claim reporting requirements.

Treatment of Information

Gallagher understands the need to protect the confidentiality and security of your confidential and sensitive information and strives to comply with applicable data privacy and security laws. Your confidential and sensitive information will be protected by Gallagher and only used to perform services for you; provided that Gallagher may disclose and transfer your information to our affiliates, agents or vendors that have a need to know such information in connection with the provision of such services (including insurance markets, as necessary, for marketing, quoting, placing and/or servicing insurance coverages). We may also disclose such information as required by applicable data protection laws or the order of any court or tribunal, subject to our providing you with prior notice as permitted by law.

We will (i) implement appropriate administrative, physical and technical safeguards to protect personal information; (ii) timely report security incidents involving personal information to affected parties and/or regulatory bodies; (iii) create and maintain required policies and procedures; and (iv) comply with data subjects' rights, as applicable. To the extent applicable under associated data protection laws, you are a "business" or "controller" and Gallagher is a "service provider" or "data processor." You will ensure that any information provided to Gallagher has been provided with any required notices and that you have obtained all required consents, if any and where required, or are otherwise authorized to transfer all information to Gallagher and enable Gallagher to process the information for the purposes described in this Proposal and as set forth in Gallaher's Privacy Policy located at https://www.ajg.com/privacy-policy/. Gallagher may update its Privacy Policy from time to time and any updates will be posted to such site.

Dispute Resolution

Gallagher does not expect that it will ever have a formal dispute with any of its clients. However, in the event that one should arise, we should each strive to achieve a fair, expedient and efficient resolution and we'd like to clearly outline the resolution process.

A. If the parties have a dispute regarding Gallagher's services or the relationship governed by this Proposal ("**Dispute**"), each party agrees to resolve that Dispute by mediation. If mediation fails to resolve the Dispute, you and Gallagher agree to binding arbitration. Each party waives all rights to commence litigation in court to resolve a Dispute, and specifically waives all rights to pursue relief by class action or mass action in court or through arbitration. However, the parties do not waive the ability to seek a court order of injunction in aid of the mediation and arbitration required by these Terms.

- B. The party asserting a Dispute must provide a written notice ("Notice") of the claim to the other party and to the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") in accordance with its Commercial Arbitration Rules and Mediation Procedures. All Dispute resolutions will take place in Chicago, IL, unless you and Gallagher agree to another location. The parties will equally divide all costs of the mediation and arbitration proceedings and will each pay their own attorneys' fees. All matters will be before a neutral, impartial and disinterested mediator or arbitrator(s) that have at least 20 years' experience in commercial and insurance coverage disputes.
- C. Mediation will occur within sixty (60) days of filing the Notice with the AAA. Mediation results will be reduced to a memorandum of understanding signed by you, Gallagher and the mediator. A Dispute that is not resolved in mediation will commence to binding arbitration. For Disputes in excess of \$500,000, either party may elect to have the Dispute heard by a panel of three (3) arbitrators. The award of the arbitrator(s) must be accompanied by a reasoned opinion prepared and signed by the arbitrator(s). Except as may be required by law, neither you, Gallagher, nor a mediator or arbitrator may disclose the existence, content or results of any Dispute or its dispute resolution proceeding without the prior written consent of both you and Gallagher.
