### MINUTES OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING DECEMBER 19, 2023

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 109 (the "District") met in regular session, open to the public, at the Atascocita Waste Water Treatment Plant, 5003 Atascocita Road, Humble, Texas 77346, on December 19, 2023, at 5:30 p.m.; whereupon the roll was called of the Board, to-wit:

Owen H. Parker, President Chris Green, Vice President Cheryl Moore, Secretary Robin Sulpizio, Assistant Secretary Nancy A. Frank, Assistant Secretary

All members of the Board were present, except Directors Sulpizio and Frank, thus constituting a quorum. Also attending all or parts of the meeting were Sergeant Steve Romero of Harris County Precinct 4 Constable's Office; Mr. Chris Davy of Ad Valorem Appraisals, tax assessor and collector for the District; Mr. Cory Burton of Municipal Accounts & Consulting, LP ("MAC"), bookkeeper for the District; Mr. Bill Kotlan of BGE, Inc. ("BGE"), engineers for the District; Mr. Clint Gehrke of Water Waste Water Management Services, Inc. ("WWWMS"), operator for the District; and Mr. Dimitri Millas, Ms. Leslie Bacon and Ms. Jane Maher of Norton Rose Fulbright US LLP ("NRF"), attorneys for the District.

**Call to Order.** President Parker called the meeting to order in accordance with notice posted pursuant to law, copies of certificates of posting of which are attached hereto as *Exhibit A*, and the following business was transacted:

- 1. **Public Comments**. There were no public comments.
- 2. **Minutes**. The Board considered the proposed minutes of meeting held on November 21, 2023, previously distributed to the Board. Upon motion by Director Moore, seconded by Director Green, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the meeting held on November 21, 2023, as presented.
- 3. **Security Report**. President Parker recognized Sergeant Romero, who reviewed the Security Report for the month of November 2023, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit B*.
- 4. **Review Operations Report, authorize repairs, and approve termination of delinquent accounts in accordance with the District's Rate Order**. President Parker recognized Mr. Gehrke, who presented the Operations Report dated December 19, 2023 and a list of delinquent accounts, copies of which are attached hereto as *Exhibit C*. Mr. Gehrke reported that 92.20% of the water pumped was billed for the period November 1, 2023 through November 30, 2023. Discussion ensued regarding the holidays and the service cut-off date.

Upon motion by Director Moore, seconded by Director Green, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Operations Report and to approve termination of the delinquent accounts in accordance with the terms of the District's Rate Order and to delay the service cut-off date until January 4, 2024.

5. **Tax Collector's Report and authorize payment of certain bills**. President Parker recognized Mr. Davy, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report for the month of November 2023, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit D*.

Upon motion by Director Moore, seconded by Director Green, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report and to authorize payment of checks therein, from the Tax Account to the persons, in the amounts, and for the purposes listed therein.

6. Review Bookkeeper's Report, and authorize payment of certain bills, and approve quarterly investment report. President Parker recognized Mr. Burton, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Bookkeeper's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit E*.

Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Moore, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Bookkeeper's Report and to authorize payment of the checks in the amounts, to the persons, and for the purposes listed therein, to adopt the Bookkeeper's Report as presented.

- 7. **Engineer's Report**. President Parker recognized Mr. Kotlan, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Engineer's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit F*.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the utility relocations related to the FM 1960 widening and stated that there is no update this month.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the Water Plant No. 2 Expansion, and stated that BGE conducted a warranty inspection on December 14, 2023.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the Barents Drive Lift Station. He stated that the contracts were prepared this month and that a preconstruction meeting is being planned for January.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the Wastewater Treatment Plant and stated that the construction at the treatment plant is ongoing.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the Lead and Copper Rule. He stated that the deadline for Phase 1 is October 16, 2024.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the Emergency Preparedness Plan ("EPP"). He stated that the EPP has been submitted to the TCEQ.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the Woodland Hills Tract. He stated that the District is working on a development agreement with the developer.

Mr. Kotlan reported on the Madden Tract and stated that there is no change this month.

Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Moore, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to accept the Engineer's Report.

8. Matters pertaining to 2024 Directors election, including Resolution Authorizing Publication of Notice of Intent Not to Use an Electronic Voting Machine. President Parker recognized Mr. Millas, who reviewed the Resolution Authorizing Publication of Notice of Intent Not to Use an Electronic Voting System for the 2024 Directors Election (the "Resolution"), a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit G* He reported that should Harris County not offer joint election services, the District is permitted to hold a directors election without use of an electronic voting machine. He stated that the notice of exemption from use of an electronic voting system must be published in a newspaper in general circulation in the District to comply with the statute.

Upon motion by Director Moore, seconded by Director Green, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Resolution.

9. **Discuss emergency text message notification system**. It was the consensus of the Board to defer this item until January.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE BOARD, the meeting was adjourned.

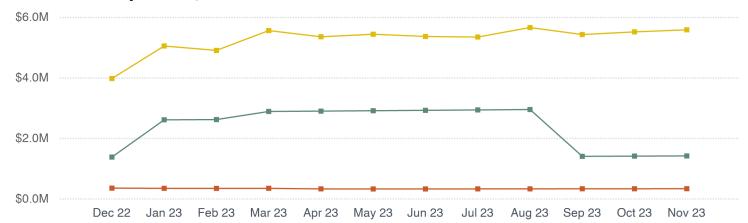
### Spotlight On Cost Of Water And Wastewater Per 10,000 Gallons

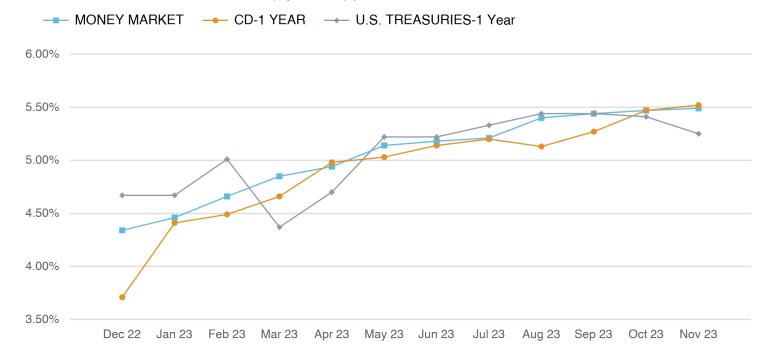

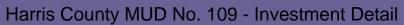

# RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF INTENT NOT TO USE AN ELECTRONIC VOTING SYSTEM FOR THE 2024 DIRECTORS ELECTION

WHEREAS, Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 109 (the "District") is required to hold a Directors Election on the first Saturday in May of even numbered years for each open position unless the candidate for such position is unopposed; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 49.111 of the Texas Water Code, a district is exempt from the acquisition, lease or use of an electronic voting system for an election if (i) the most recently scheduled district directors' election was not held because each candidate was unopposed, or (ii) fewer than 250 voters voted at the most recently held district directors' election; and

WHEREAS, a district eligible for the exemption must publish notice in a newspaper of general circulation in an area that includes the district or mail notice to each voter in the district regarding the district's intention to hold an election without providing a voting station that meets the requirements for accessibility under 42 USC Section 15481(a)(3) on election day and during the period for early voting by personal appearance; and

WHEREAS, the district must comply with a request for an accessible voting station if the request is received not later than the 45<sup>th</sup> day before the date of the election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DISTRICT THAT:

- 1. The Board hereby finds that it is eligible for the exemption from the acquisition, lease or use of an electronic voting system under Section 49.111 of the Texas Water Code.
- 2. The Board hereby directs the District's election agent to arrange for publication of a notice in a newspaper of general circulation in an area that includes the District regarding the District's intention to hold an election without providing a voting station that meets the requirements for accessibility under 42 USC Section 15481(a)(3) either on election day or during the period for early voting by personal appearance, in substantially the form attached hereto.
- 3. The Board hereby directs the District's election agent to notify the Board in the event she receives a request for an accessible voting system not later than the 45<sup>th</sup> day before the date of the election so that arrangements can be made to provide an accessible voting station on election day and during the period for early voting by personal appearance, as required by Section 49.111 of the Texas Water Code.
