MINUTES OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MARCH 21, 2023

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 109 (the "District") met in regular session, open to the public, at the Atascocita Waste Water Treatment Plant, 5003 Atascocita Road, Humble, Texas 77346, on March 21, 2023, at 5:30 p.m.; whereupon the roll was called of the Board, to-wit:

Owen H. Parker, President Chris Green, Vice President Cheryl Moore, Secretary Robin Sulpizio, Assistant Secretary Nancy A. Frank, Assistant Secretary

All members of the Board were present. Also attending all or parts of the meeting were Lieutenant Steve Romero and Deputy Elizabeth Krieg of Harris County Precinct 4 Constable's Office; Mr. Chris Davy of Ad Valorem Appraisals, tax assessor and collector for the District; Ms. Susana Reyes of Municipal Accounts & Consulting, LP ("MAC"), bookkeeper for the District; Mr. Bill Kotlan of BGE, Inc. ("BGE"), engineer for the District; Mr. Clint Gehrke and Mr. Evan Gehrke of Water Waste Water Management Services, Inc. ("WWWMS"), operator for the District; and Mr. Dimitri Millas, Ms. Leslie Bacon and Ms. Jane Maher of Norton Rose Fulbright US LLP ("NRF"), attorneys for the District.

Call to Order. President Parker called the meeting to order in accordance with notice posted pursuant to law, copies of certificates of posting of which are attached hereto as *Exhibit A*, and the following business was transacted:

- 1. **Public Comments**. There were no public comments.
- 2. **Minutes**. The Board considered the proposed minutes of meeting held on February 21, 2023, and March 4, 2023, previously distributed to the Board. Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the meeting held on February 21, 2023, and March 4, 2023, as presented.
- 3. **Security Report**. President Parker recognized Lieutenant Romero, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Security Report for the month of February 2023, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit B*.

Upon motion by Director Frank, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Security Report.

4. Review Operations Report, authorize repairs, approve termination of delinquent accounts in accordance with the District's Rate Order. President Parker recognized Mr. Gehrke, who presented the Operations Report dated March 21, 2023 and a list of delinquent accounts, copies of which are attached hereto as *Exhibit C.* Mr. Gehrke reported that 94.79% of the water pumped was billed for the period February 1, 2023 through February 28,

Mr. Gehrke reported on various maintenance items.

Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Operations Report and to approve termination of the delinquent accounts in accordance with the terms of the District's Rate Order.

5. **Tax Collector's Report and authorize payment of certain bills**. President Parker recognized Mr. Davy, who reviewed the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report for the month of February 2023, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit D*.

Upon motion by Director Sulpizio, seconded by Director Green, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Tax Assessor and Collector's Report and to authorize payment of check numbers 2269 through 2273, from the Tax Account to the persons, in the amounts, and for the purposes listed therein.

- 6. Discuss delinquent tax attorney engagement and take any necessary action regarding the collection of delinquent taxes. Mr. Millas stated that the District has an evergreen contract with Perdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins & Mott, LLP ("Perdue") for delinquent collections. He stated that each party can terminate upon 30 days' written notice, otherwise the contract automatically rolls over for another term. No action was taken.
- 7. Review Bookkeeper's Report, and authorize payment of certain bills, and approve quarterly investment report. President Parker recognized Ms. Reyes, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Bookkeeper's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit E*.

Upon motion by Director Frank, seconded by Director Sulpizio, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Bookkeeper's Report and to authorize payment of the checks in the amounts, to the persons, and for the purposes listed therein, to adopt the Bookkeeper's Report as presented.

- 8. **Engineer's Report**. President Parker recognized Mr. Kotlan, who presented to and reviewed with the Board the Engineer's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as *Exhibit F*.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the utility relocations related to the FM 1960 widening and stated that the Board previously approved the change order and that the Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT") is preparing the paperwork for the change order.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the Water Plant No. 2 Expansion, and stated that BGE is working with the contractor and WWWMS to resolve warranty issues. He reviewed an invoice for additional drainage work completed at Water Plant No. 2, a copy of which is attached to the Engineer's Report. He recommended approval of the invoice from Schier Construction in the amount of \$10,800.
- Mr. Kotlan reported on the Barents Drive Lift Station. He stated that BGE has submitted the variance request and is waiting on City of Houston approval.

Mr. Kotlan reported on the Wastewater Treatment Plant and stated that the project is in construction. He stated that the proposed gates are being manufactured and should be available in April.

Mr. Kotlan reported on the Wastewater Treatment Plant Permit Renewal. He stated that the public review period ended on December 5 and that BGE expects the final permit this week.

Upon motion by Director Green, seconded by Director Frank, after full discussion and the question being put to the Board, the Board voted unanimously to accept the Engineer's Report and to approve the invoice from Schier Construction in the amount of \$10,800 for the drainage inlet at Water Plant No. 2.

- 9. **Discuss renewal of District insurance (expires May 22, 2023).** Mr. Millas stated that the District's insurance will expire May 22, 2023. He stated that NRF will request a proposal from the District's current provider for the April meeting.
- 10. **Such other matters that may come before the Board.** There were no further reports.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE BOARD, the meeting was adjourned.

Spotlight On Wholesale Water Providers

In the State of Texas, Groundwater Reduction Plans, Conservation Districts and River & Water Authorities, have been created to assist in converting the area within their boundaries from using groundwater to predominantly surface water in order to combat subsidence and to protect aquifers and natural water resources. These providers acquire, develop and deliver a long- term supply of potable surface water to their users. Their primary assignment is to develop and implement a strategy that requires a reduction in groundwater usage & promotes conservation. In general, these providers are not taxing entities, as such, funding for the future water supply, and the infrastructure through which to deliver it, is being accomplished through the sale of revenue bonds, and paid for by revenues generated by groundwater pumpage fees and surface water sales. Over the last 10 years, these fees have become one of the largest expenses of Special Purpose Districts.

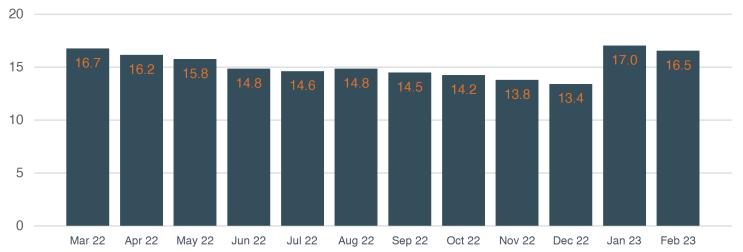

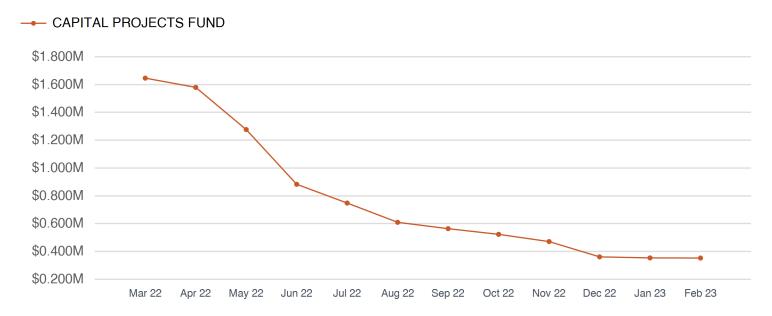

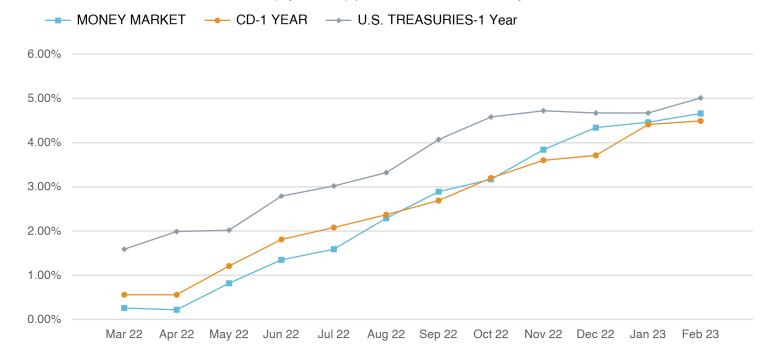

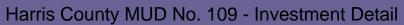
